Pursuant to Rules 8.01(b) and 8.04(a)(8) of the Texas Disciplinary Rules of Professional Conduct, failure or refusal to timely furnish a response or other information requested by the Chief Disciplinary Counsel, without timely asserting legal grounds to do so, constitutes Professional Misconduct.

Disciplinary Proceedings, including the investigation and processing of a Complaint, are strictly confidential and not subject to discovery. The pendency, subject matter and status of a Disciplinary Proceeding may be disclosed by the Complainant, Respondent, or the Chief Disciplinary Counsel if the Respondent has waived confidentiality or the Disciplinary Proceeding is based upon a conviction for a serious crime.
